## **Important Information - Supportive Housing Services Spreadsheet**

**March 1, 2018**

This spreadsheet was first created in 2011 to assist Case Coordinators and other healthcare providers such as emergency departments, and acute care, in understanding the services offered by Supportive Housing.

The document provides information on the Core Services that **all** Supportive Housing Residences provide. It also provides information on Supplemental services or amenities that some residences may be able to provide.

The document does not provide the costs. We urge all health care providers interacting with potential clients, to instruct them to first go to our website at [www.careoptions.ca](http://www.careoptions.ca) or call LTCAM at 1-204-477-9888 and review the 10 Supportive Housing residences in Winnipeg. The Supportive Housing section of the website offers step by step information on how to choose a residence that offers the services/amenities that meet the client's needs. Virtual tours are offered here as well as other important information. There is a video that explains and gives examples of clients who may be eligible for Supportive Housing. This was created in collaboration with WRHA. There is a check list to use when touring the Residences. There is also a calculator that can be downloaded or used on line to calculate current living expenses. Wait times and vacancies are posted here and are updated weekly.

Once this information has been reviewed, then it is time for a physical tour and a discussion of the costs for rent and services, with the Supportive Housing owner/operator. The Supportive Housing owner/operator is the person with the financial knowledge to have these discussions. Bookmarks/fridge magnets are available to leave with the client for easy reference.
