Manitoba	Provincial statement: *\$340.00 or the pre-existing base fee set by service provider, whichever is lower: https://www.gov.mb.ca/health/ems/ambulance_fees.html City of Winnipeg Website statement: \$529.00 (subsidized) as of January 1, 2019 The Provincial budget 2019 states ambulance costs will be reduced to \$250.00
Ontario	Cost: co-payment charge of 45.00 if you are a resident & have valid Ont. Health card. Or your ambulance cost is fully covered if: a physician deems your ambulance services medically necessary. -Also fully covered if: you are receiving certain homecare services approved for this exemption, living in long term care, home for special care or residence for psychiatric patients http://www.health.gov.on.ca/en/public/publications/ohip/amb.aspx
